# 2009 Jimmy Fund Baseball Tournament

## Rule Adjustments

Team Roster: Up to 14 players per team (submitted prior to first game.)

Pitching: Based on number of innings not number of pitches.

- A player may pitch a total of 12 innings during the regular tournament games. Pitching more than three innings in a single day (either single game, first game of a doubleheader, or total in a doubleheader) requires one calendar day of rest. A single pitch thrown constitutes an inning. Players that reach a playoff game and who are still eligible to pitch (pitched no more than 3 innings on Saturday and/or Sunday) may pitch an additional three innings in the playoff games.
- If a pitcher pitches 3 innings or less on any given day, they may pitch on the next day. If a pitcher throws 4 innings, they are NOT eligible to pitch the next calendar day or in the next game on the same day. This applies to pitchers who throw on Saturday, for Sunday's playoffs.

Protests: All protests will be settled on the field before play is resumed.

Batting Order: The 9-10 division will use a continuous batting order. The 11-12 division will have nine batters in the order at any one time. All players in attendance for a game must play and bat in accordance with Little League Rules.

The team leading their pool at the end of the day on Saturday will advance to Sunday's playoffs. In the event of a tie the following tiebreakers shall govern:

- Head to head results
- In the event of a three way tie, the team that allowed the fewest runs in the games with the teams they are tied with shall advance.
- If a tie still exists between two teams the head to head game shall then govern.

Managers must verify scores and pitchers used. At the conclusion of each team's game the manager or coach must report the final score, pitchers used and number of innings pitched.
